Tuesday, December 06, 2016: The sixth edition of Teamwork Arts' Kahaani Festival concluded its final day with stories and a lot more! At the Jayshree Periwal International School storytellers, magicians, artistes, dancers and musicians from across the world engaged with school children from the ages 4-14 taking them through a world of stories through multiple art forms.

Highlights

- **Christian Duda's** exclusive 'Wordshop' **Being Pig**, got good response on the second day along with **Kabuliwaala – The Musical Show** that enchanted children and adults alike.
- Writer, editor and storyteller **Rituparna Ghosh** who practices all three forms of storytelling – written, visual and oral, conducted a storytelling sessions **What's in the story bag? And Hippo! Get out of water!** which held the children in awe. She later conducted a **'Wordshop' Topsy Turvy Tales** as well.
- **Divya Seth Shah** took **Centrestage** to speak on Theatre and Storytelling. During Artists Speak she also spoke to the audience about the importance of



storytelling and how it has shaped her journey as an artiste. **Roshan Abbas** who founded the storytelling community for artistes in Mumbai called, 'Kommune' to develop a space for creative minds to express and nurture through workshops and performances.

- **Rahul Kharbanda's Fun with Magic** performance and a workshop by the same name were a big draw.
- Writer, director, musician and martial artist **Aditya Roy** who has spent three years as assistant director of the musical production Zangoora – The Gypsy Prince at the Kingdom of Dreams, conducted his workshop '**Stories in Motion,**' where he explored the use of the human body as a chief tool for storytelling using the space around them.
- Delhi based puppeteer **Varun Narain** who believes in the freedom of expression devoid of any trauma performed his crowdpuller show '**Into the Box**'.

The Kahaani festival explores and reimagines the art of storytelling through oral traditions, music, theatre, dance and puppetry along with various other art forms.

Taking learning beyond the classroom, the Kahaani –through workshops, performances and storytelling sessions- creates an atmosphere for children to freely explore the realm of their imagination and creativity.

Produced by Teamwork Arts, the Kahaani festival travels across India with stories and storytellers from all around the world. Beyond the conventional forms of storytelling, the festival also features artists with unique styles providing them with a platform to showcase their art.
